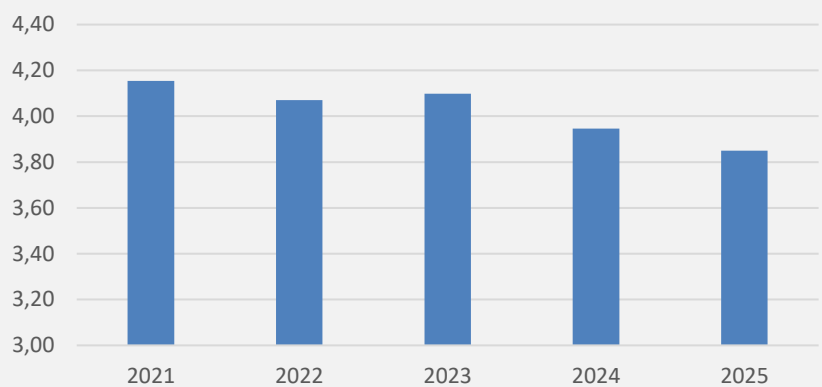


Smart Packaging Solutions – Loenen (NL)

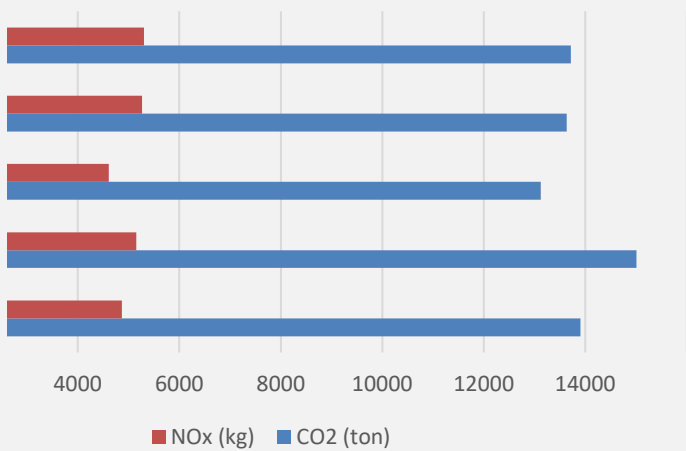
The production of solid board is an **energy-intensive** process. It is our responsibility to reduce emissions by **limiting** energy consumption.

Energy consumption (GJ) per tonne of product

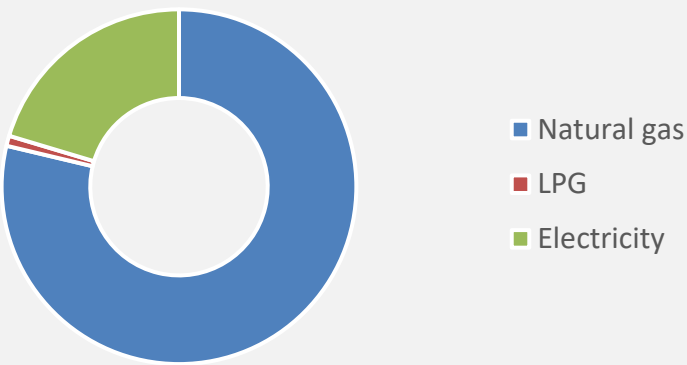


In 2025, we produced more than in 2024, and we also produced more efficiently, consuming less energy per tonne of product.

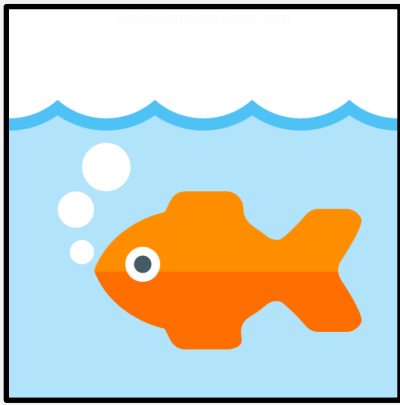
Emissions



Energy Sources (in GJ)

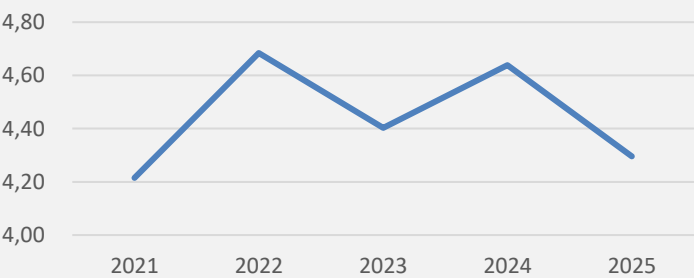


Natural gas is used for **heat generation** and space heating, LPG for internal transport. External transport has been outsourced to third parties.

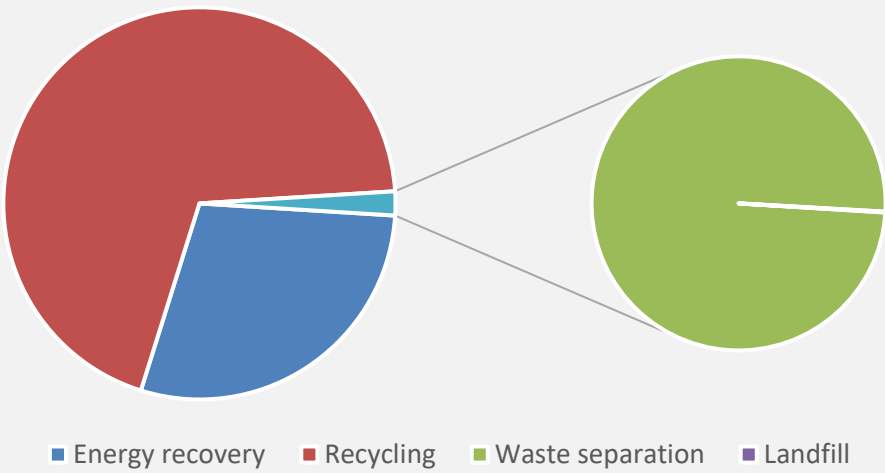


For cardboard production, **untreated water** is used from the Apeldoorn canal. In 2024, only canal water was used, in 2025, we had to use **groundwater** due to drought.

Waste 2025

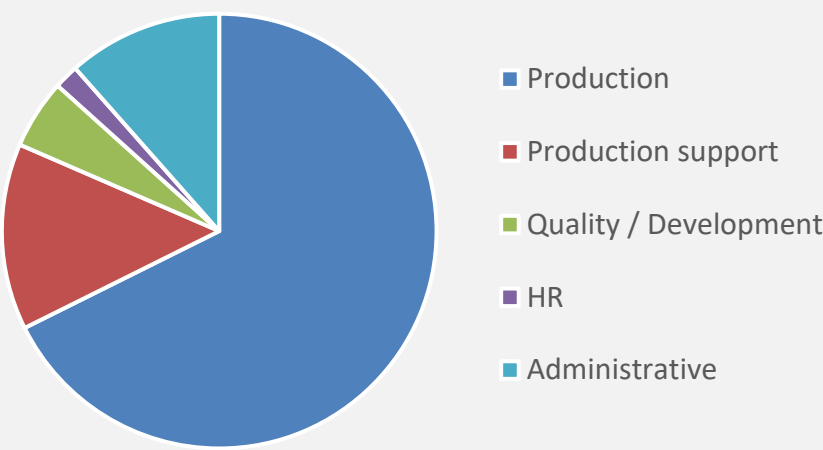


The bulk of industrial waste consists of rejects from the waste paper that find a **useful application** in energy generation and reuse elsewhere.

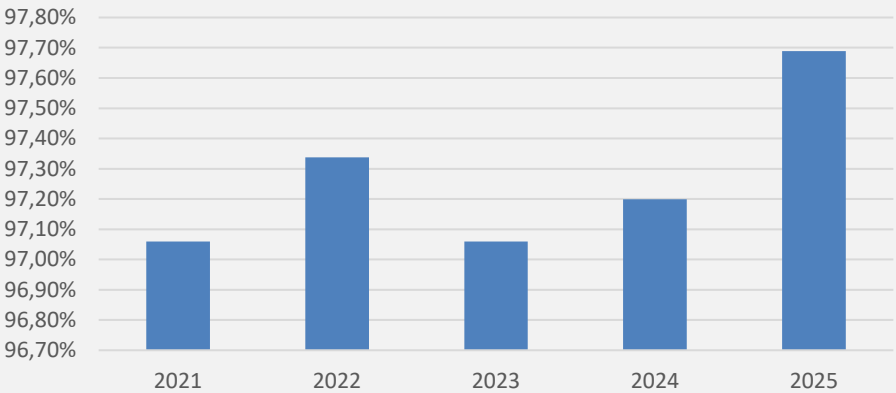
With approx. **200 colleagues**, approx. 74,000t cardboard was produced in 2025. Cardboard finds its way around the world, with the main market being frozen and chilled foods.

We have an **FSC certificate**. To produce cardboard, we use paper for recycling and FSC-certified liners.

Employees - 196FTE



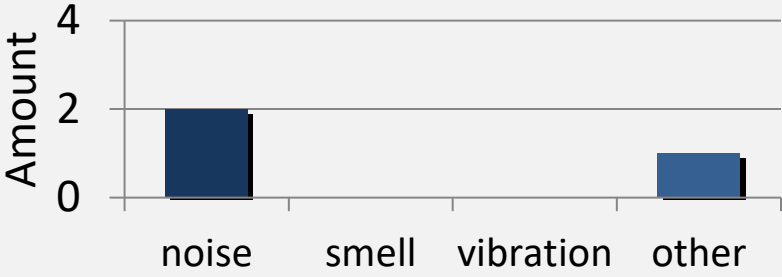
COD removal efficiency



Water is treated in our **own wastewater treatment plant** so that it can meet the requirements of the **surface water**. Due to increase in the dirt load coming in with the waste paper, the load on water treatment has increased. An important parameter for the operation of the treatment plant is the **COD** removal efficiency.

Environmental care is one of the pillars from which we derive our licence to operate as a company. We are looking at all kinds of opportunities that we can incorporate into our operations to reduce environmental impact. Examples include sourcing paper from the region, collaborating with other companies to exchange raw materials, participating in consultations with municipalities, the province and fellow companies on the energy file, environmental certification through ISO 14001 and FSC certification. But also by participating in environmental, occupational health & safety and energy consultations organised by the industry association, through which we share our knowledge and experiences for the benefit of all involved.

External complaints- 2025



Three external complaints were registered in 2024. Two were about noise and one about paper that ended up in a garden.

In 2024, **two external complaints** were registered



In 2025, **4 lost-time injuries** were recorded with own staff, and 2 with third-party staff. These resulted in a total of 17 days of absence.

There was **one fire** where the sprinkler system activated. There were **no environmental incidents** affecting air, soil or water.
